Hong Fook partners with a group of bicultural psychiatrists to facilitate access to psychiatric assessment, treatment, injection services, case management and related supportive services. The Asian Community Psychiatric Clinic (Asian Clinic) focuses its resources on the provision of ethno-specific assessment and consultation of clients in the East and Southeast Asian communities.

The Asian Clinic at the **Markham Office** offers psychiatric assessment and treatment for youth and their families of Chinese background.

Our services

Specifically, at the Asian Clinic in HF Youth & Family Hub in Markham, services offered include:

- Comprehensive assessment
- Education for youth/young adult and families
- Pharmacological therapy

Accepted clients

At Markham, we offer services to clients age 16 to 25 and their family, and who meets one of the below three criteria:

- 1) Youth/Young Adult Assessment; or
- 2) Family Assessment with Youth/Young Adult attending; or
- 3) Family Assessment without Youth/Young Adult (e.g. parenting issues).

Referral procedure

The referral procedure to see a psychiatrist **in Markham** is the same as it is to all of Asian Clinic:

1. Referring General Practitioner (GP) contacts Hong Fook at 416-493-4242, and completes an Asian Clinic referral form.
2. Administrative staff passes all new referrals to the Medical Director of the Asian Clinic for screening.
3. Administrative staff sends the referral source a letter of acknowledgment about the result of the screening. If a client is accepted to the Asian Clinic's service, administrative staff will book the first appointment and inform the referring GP of the appointment date in this letter. Referring GP will in turn notify client about the appointment date.
4. Follow-up appointment will be offered to the client directly by the Asian Clinic psychiatrist and clinician.
