Joint Message from Our President & Executive Director : Katherine Wong & Bonnie Wong

Welcome to the 9th Annual General Meeting of HF Connecting Health Nurse Practitioner-Led Clinic (Clinic). Globally this has been another challenging year with the COVID-19 pandemic which has dramatically changed Annual General Meeting Date: Tuesday, June 28, 2022

how we live and work. On behalf of the Clinic, we want to let you know that our thoughts are with those who are affected by this pandemic.

The Clinic is carefully moving towards possibly pandemic recovery and to reshape a new normal by embracing changes as opportunities. Our first priority is the health and safety of our clients, service users and staff. To that end, we have been working closely with health authorities e.g. Scarborough Ontario Health Team (SOHT), Toronto Public Health and Ministry of Health (MOH) to assure we are doing all we can, in addition to COVID precautions, to align our practices and contribute to positive health outcomes.

Among the Clinic's clients, the non-vaccinated rate continues to drop. Many clients were initially skeptical of the COVID-19 vaccination. Changes were made possible by the collaboration, communication and team work of Clinic staff to ensure vaccines are available at the Clinic and to persistently educate with the "vaccine conversation" in English and in clients' preferred Cantonese/Mandarin languages. We continue to provide vaccine shots.

Increasing access to Clinic services is another priority. With funding support from the Alliance for Healthier Communities and the MOH, we established an online system for Clinic clients to directly book telephone appointment for their preferred time with their Nurse Practitioner (NP) to meet non-urgent health needs.

In collaboration and coordination with community partners, in-person programs have resumed at the Clinic with small volumes of clients such as foot care with Foot Care Academy. We are thankful to receive 2 grants from the Federal government: one would help to reach more seniors with increasing frequency of the New Horizon for Seniors 55+ Fit Program and the second, would help hire 2 summer students to support administrative duties and the Client Satisfaction Survey.

Recently the Clinic's Lead NP and consulting psychiatrist were invited to present their experience in providing care during the pandemic at the Diversity and Equity in Mental Health and Addictions Conference with the theme to promote inclusion, diversity, equity and anti-racism (IDEA) and system transformation in COVID-19 recovery. The virtual conference with over 130 participants was hosted by Hong Fook Mental Health Association in partnership with 10 other organizations including hospitals, mental health organizations, primary care organizations and universities.

For this year the Clinic's strategic direction is a refinement of its previous 2018-2021 Strategic Plan. In a regular process of this work, the next Plan would have been developed for 2022. With necessary priority on managing the COVID-19 pandemic and pivoting with various precautions, staff, management and the Board agreed to work with the three themes still relevant towards the Clinic's Mission and Vision. We want to take this opportunity to thank the MOH for ongoing funding and encouragement and we look forward to receive their support for our Clinic service expansion; we have been receiving daily community requests to accept new clients.

We express our heartfelt gratitude to our clients, frontline staff, collaborating physicians and psychiatrists, Board and Committees, community partners and volunteers for their trust and support and look forward to growing and thriving together.

The past two years have been challenging for everyone in the world because of the COVID-19 pandemic from different aspects. As the city and the nation re-open, our clinic has opened up more in-person days for our clients with phone call screening prior to visit to ensure everyone's safety. Our phone call consults also remain as part of our services for clients who prefer to stay

home. We continued to work hard and strive to stay connected with all our clients. To assist the government vaccine roll out plan, we also provided individual check-ins regarding COVID-19 vaccine education to minimize hesitations from our clients. We have also revamped our community programs and adapted to a virtual platform, in order to continue to provide support for our community and to reduce social isolation for populations that are in need. With additional funding from the New Horizon for Seniors Program, we were able to provide much more services and programs and support the seniors with language barriers throughout this challenging time. In response to the increased demand on the healthcare system and to maintain continuity of care for clients with COVID-19, our clinic implemented a systematic COVID-19 monitoring program, COVID@Home Monitoring in Primary Care. It created the opportunity for clinicians to provide appropriate care, prevent emergency room visits, and support early detection of worsening cases. Our clinic has registered as one of the sites to provide COVID-19 vaccine for the community. Along with the Alliance for Healthier Communities , we have also adapted the online booking system for clients to better access our services at their convenience.

We as a clinic continue to follow the directions from the government to re-design our programs and services to continue serve our community. Together, we will get stronger and bring life back to the new "normal".

How do we do this year 2021-2022 Our Clients says

- According to our patient satisfaction survey,
 - 92% of our clients would recommend our clinic to their family and friends
 - 92% of our clients rated their experience in our clinic as "good," "very good" or "excellent"
 - 90% of our clients feel welcome in our clinic
 - 76% of the clients reported that our clinic staff spend enough time with them
 - Close to 80% of the clients felt to be involved as much as we can in their treatment plan
 - 76% of the clients reported "very satisfied" or "Satisfied" with our overall experience of virtual care
 - More than 60% of the clients from the survey reported that they may continue choosing care through virtual/phone when in-person visit is more available in the future.
 - 100% of the 55+ Fit + Wellness Check-up participants felt this series of program is helpful.
 - 100% of the 55+ Fit + Wellness Check-up participants felt this series of program has helped them making healthier choices

HF Connecting Health Nurse Practitioner-Led Clinic was approved for the small community grant for year 2021-2022. Because of the funding, we were able to coordinate the senior program, 55+ Fit with wellness check-up, to support our seniors in the community over the COVID-19 pandemic time. Our goal is to empower and support our seniors, to promote active living through their network and to reduce social isolation of seniors in the community. Hundreds of seniors in the community with language barriers have participated and benefited from this program series. They have expressed that their wellbeing has significant improved with the virtual/phone peer support system and weekly seminars. They have also expressed (100% of the survey result) that this program had made them more active and healthier. They have also obtained more knowledge and information to make healthier choices.




