### CELEBRATING A DECADE OF CULTURALLY COMPE-TENT PRIMARY CARE AND LOOKING FORWARD

HF Connecting Health Nurse Practitioner-Led Clinic officially opened its doors in September 2013 with the vision to provide culturally competent primary care to the equity deserving populations in the community, with a special focus on making primary care accessible to clients with mental health challenges. A group of supportive and dedicated community members from Hong Fook Mental Health Association was behind the birth and establishment of the clinic.

We have since grown to be a robust clinic serving over 4600 clients (over 3200 rostered and 1400 non-rostered) with a dedicated team of four nurse practitioners, two nurses, a social worker, dietitian, health promoter, and two administrative staff. In addition, we have great support from four family physicians and two psychiatrists we collaborate with for consultations. Our nurse practitioner-led clinic has been known to provide high-quality, culturally competent healthcare to individuals and families in our diverse community. The dedication and tireless efforts of our staff and volunteers have been instrumental in shaping our success, and we are immensely proud of the impact we have made in improving the health and well-being of our patients.

On behalf of the board and staff of the HF Connecting Health Nurse Practitioner-Led Clinic, we would like to express our deepest gratitude for the community you have helped to build over the years. As we prepare for our upcoming 10th anniversary in September, we reflect on the journey we have undertaken together to advance the health equity of the communities in the Scarborough area and beyond. Whether it be our dedicated healthcare professionals, our steadfast funder Ministry of Health, our partners in the community, or our valued patients, caregivers and family members, your unwavering support has been the driving force behind our achievements. ## MESSAGE FROM HFCHNPLC SOCIAL WORKER

### Teaching from a respectable and admirable psychiatrist

With resources from the Mental Health Fund, our team invited a distinguished guest, Dr. Mark Lachman, to provide us training on "Mental Health & Primary Care" in March 2023. Dr. Lachmann is the Medical Lead of Sinai Health's Bridgepoint campus. He is a geriatric psychiatrist working with patients in acute, rehabilitation, long-term care, and community settings. Dr. Lachmann is also an assistant professor in Geriatric Psychiatry, at the University of Toronto.

Dr. Lachmann covered topics like attachment, neuroscience, personality, meaning of family, DBT, and the safe use of medications for different types of mental illnesses. His teaching once again has shown the link between the person and the environment. We learned that our experiences in different environments since birth shape who we are. The functioning and connectivity of the brain forms our beliefs through our relations with different people in our lives. The failure to integrate concept of self/other could result in interpersonal dysfunction or possibly personality disorder. I kept pondering on the statement, "we age the way we live", from the presentation after the training.

The one thing that stood out in my mind about Dr. Lachmann and his presentation is who he is. By providing treatments and support for his patients, Dr. Lachmann has shown a deep care of the wellness of his patients and families. He uses a holistic and team approach in his work. I am impressed by his openness, generosity, humbleness, dedication, and compassion. He is willing to walk an extra mile to support the needs of his patients and families so that they can lead a life with quality and dignity. Dr. Lachmann is a role model to learn from in health care.



















Clients were able to book appointments within 1.5 days


**97%** of our clients were able to book their appointments within an acceptable timeframe


**82%** of our clients felt our staff gave them an opportunity to ask questions about their treatment
