

Dear guests, volunteers, colleagues and friends,

Welcome to the 2024 Hong Fook Gala dedicated to empowering the next generation of youth mental health in Asian communities. Our Future. Redefined.

Today, Canada is experiencing a mental health crisis: 1 in 5 Canadians suffers from a mental illness. By the time Canadians reach 40, they have a 50% chance of developing a mental illness. Youth between 15 and 24 are more likely to experience mental health challenges than any other age group. As the most severe outcome of mental health problems, youth suicides are on the rise at an alarming rate. The time to act is NOW.

Language and cultural barriers are two significant factors preventing youth from accessing mental health care, especially in immigrant countries like Canada. That is why we must act now to expand culturally competent care in the language with which youth feel comfortable.

As a provincial leader in providing mental health care, Hong Fook Mental Health Association is a fully accredited charitable organization with Exemplary Standing, the highest level of accreditation status awarded by Accreditation Canada. Hong Fook has received the Advancing Minority Mental Health Award from the American Psychiatric Association Foundation. Our organization serves diverse communities in five languages in addition to English. In 2022-2023, 4,050 individuals with mental health needs were served and 8,112 community members were reached out through our service spectrum from "promoting wellness" to "managing illness".

However, there aren't sufficient resources to respond to this growing need. This year, we are raising funds to establish much needed mental health services targeting youth. We need every dollar we can raise to tackle this unmet need. With your support, we will reduce wait time while serving a greater number of youth who are seeking help from our experienced professionals.

I am so grateful for your generosity and interest in supporting Hong Fook. Together with all of you, I am confident that we will improve mental health for our next generations.

Tonight, let's celebrate hope, inspiration and your generosity. A special shout-out goes to our donors and partners for their continued and unwavering support. Hong Fook Mental Health Foundation also extends a heart-felt thank you to our volunteers, staff and Committee members for their dedication and commitment.

BK is an award-winning educator in Toronto, with expertise in emotional literacy, sex education, and equity/inclusion.

Migrating from Hong Kong at ten, BK has been connected to Asian community through both work and play. She has been deeply shaped by Queer Asian Youth (a group that she helped found in Toronto), RAW Taiko (formerly called Raging Asian Women Taiko Drummers), and The Jam (people worldwide working on social change through love). These days, she can be found speaking to dietitians about diversity, writing curricula for transformative justice, or creating sex ed animations for Autistic youth.

24 years ago, BK spoke at Hong Fook's "Families in Transition" conference about how diasporic Asian youth – while well-attended to in academics and safety – were inadvertently anxious, lonely, and longing for connection. This year, BK is excited to share a vision for how we can continue to cultivate the ways we tend to our young. After all, she is a parent to two magical beings, as well as a daughter doing her best.

Limelight Dance Crew

Limelight Dance Crew was formed in 2015 as a Korean Pop Dance club in University of Waterloo. They create K-pop dance videos on YouTube and perform at various events, such as Toronto K-pop Concert, Waterloo Chinese New Year, Toronto Night Markets and so on. They quickly grew popularity in the Kitchener-Waterloo region, attracting all talented dancers from the GTA area. In 2017 and 2021, they won first place of Toronto K-pop World Festival hosted by Korean Consulate and UT Korean Student Association. In 2019, they placed second in Changwon Kpop World Festival hosted in Korea representing Canada. They have also ranked top 10 K-pop cover groups in Canada.

In addition to serving as the President of the Sino-Canadian Art Association, Mr. Zuo is the Chief Artist of C9 Art Gallery and the Vice President of the China International Collections Association. Among Mr. Zuo's notable work, his 'Colored Vision Debunked' series exhibition became one of the top ten Toronto news events in 2017. His anti-war piece 'Eternal Vision' caught the attention of international art critics at the 2023 New York International Contemporary Art Exhibition.

Jason Yaohsing Kao

Dr. Jason Kao is a renowned cultural worker, art critic, curator, auctioneer, and columnist. He holds a master's degree from McGill University and a doctoral degree from the University of Toronto in Canada. Dr. Kao has received numerous honours for his dedication to public service - including the Canadian Queen Elizabeth II Diamond Jubilee Medal, the Canadian King Charles Coronation Commemorative Medal, and the Canadian Fairchild TV Audience Choice Award for Social Contribution.



FUNDRAISING AND IMPACT

Since 2020, Hong Fook has been supporting Asian identifying youth aged 12 to 25 with individual counselling by our Registered Social Workers and Registered Psychotherapists. The Brief Counselling Services provide free, immediate, single-session therapy in person and online, for not only newcomer youth but also Canadian-born, second and third generation Asian youth.

The service makes a difference supporting youth isolated during the pandemic, and navigating all of life's challenges in a post-pandemic world.

- anxiety and depression symptoms
- family relationships
- school-related stress

- 67% of our clients reported sleep issues

- Help-Seeking Behavioural Change:
 84% of youth more willing to seeking help for their concerns
- Emotional Intelligence:
 74% of youth more aware of their emotions
- Clarity and Insight:
 75% of youth had a better understanding of the concerns they came for

During the pandemic, he had to stay home all day. Gradually, he started skipping classes and hardly talking to us. A teacher at school introduced me to Hong Fook's Parent

Support Network. Every weekend, they delve into different topics, offering simple yet comprehensive explanations on the mental health challenges teenagers face, along with effective solutions. Hearing about others' positive experiences within the group also filled me with inspiration and hope. Also with the counselling service support, my child now opens the door more often."
