Hong Fook Mental Health Association is a fully accredited charitable organization serving communities across the Greater Toronto Area in English and five additional languages: Cambodian, Cantonese, Korean, Mandarin and Vietnamese. Established in 1982, Hong Fook has been the provincial leader in providing evidence-based, culturally competent mental health care for Asian communities. Our organization provides a continuum of mental health services covering a wide spectrum from "promoting wellness" to "managing illness" with locations in Downtown Toronto, North York, Scarborough and Markham.

Hong Fook Mental Health Foundation drives change through philanthropy by providing the Association with critical support through the generosity of its donors. In 2001, a small group of Hong Fook volunteers came together to ensure the Association had a long-term sustainability plan, to meet the growing needs of our community and expand beyond the limits of public funding. The Foundation created a new philanthropic "table" where the historically unmet needs of the Asian communities served through the Association could be prioritized.



#### With the funding raised in 2024:

- 4,389 community members were engaged through our community talks and outreach efforts and equipped with mental health knowledge to facilitate supportive conversations, promote positive coping strategies and encourage help-seeking behaviours;
- 410 professionals from educational institutions and corporations completed our training to develop cultural competency awareness and skills, enhance support for individuals facing mental health challenges or in crisis, and promote mental well-being in the community and workplace;
- 214 youth found a safe space to gain concrete coping strategies for their mental health and 63 parents were supported to better understand and communicate with their children, through our Brief Counselling service in Toronto and York Region;
- 24 Peer Supporters were empowered to enhance their leadership skills, transforming their lived experience into unique assets. They inspired and motivated 360 peers through a diverse range of Recovery College courses and peer support groups, helping them find hope and meaning in life.



The **2025 Hong Fook Gala** will be hosted on **Saturday, June 21, 2025**, at Hilton Toronto/Markham Suites Conference Centre & Spa in Markham.

Asian Canadians are the largest and fastest growing racialized group in Canada. Compared to other groups, our community reports poorer self-rated mental health, lower levels of help seeking, and more severe mental illness symptoms by the time of an ER visit or hospitalization.

Stigma around mental health is a major barrier. While mental health awareness is growing across Canada, this stigma lingers more strongly in Asian communities. Our cultural values, which prioritize harmony, often lead many in the Asian community to suppress their emotions and feel fearful or ashamed of sharing their struggles or seeking help—sometimes until it's too late.

At Hong Fook, we aim to change this narrative—promoting open, supportive conversations that recognize mental health as essential to well-being and community resilience.

We invite you to join us at the **2025 Hong Fook Gala** "*Together for Tomorrow*", embracing the rich tapestry of diverse identities and cultural beliefs that shape our Asian community, charting a united path forward to end the stigma today for a healthier tomorrow.
